## Exploring With Watercolor

Class Information Sheet

## Materials

This is an overview of the materials needed for this class. A detailed list will be provided with the course material, however, it's very flexible.

- Paper: 6 sheets of 140 lb ( 300 gm ) Cold press watercolor paper 11 " x 15 " ( $28 \mathrm{~cm} \times 38 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
- Paint: Very flexible, colors such as Cerulean Blue, Royal Blue, Sap Green, Pyrrole Red, Quinacridone Rose Madder, Quinacridone Burnt Orange, Hansa Yellow will be used. Also, Payne's Gray will be used for value studies.
- Brushes: A large round or flat wash brush, $1 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ flat brush, medium general purpose round brush, small detail brush, small liner brush
- waterproof black sketching pen
- Sketchbook: at least 90lb mix media 7" x 10" or larger
- General art supplies

## Format A - Live Demonstration, Q\&A, Recorded Critique

- This will provide a live, weekly, 90 minute demonstration/Q\&A session
- There will a weekly recorded critique of homework


## Format B - Recorded demonstration, Q\&A, and critique
